Deep ruby. There is a slightly herbal undertone to the red and blue fruit and flinty aromas and flavors. Finishes tactile but could use a bit more fruit to buffer the noteworthy tannic backbone. Needs juicy meats like a grilled hamburger to stand up to it (the grilled meat will match well with the wine's flinty smokiness and help flesh it out too). A blend of 90 percent Montepulciano and 10 percent Sangiovese.
